DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP NOTES

As a reminder, please remain in your car in the afternoon until your child is walked out, in case you are asked to pull forward. If you are planning to pick your camper up early, the camp office must receive a written note, email or phone call informing us of the early dismissal (no later than 12:00 am that morning.) We will then have your camper waiting. Please note that the end of the day is quite busy and it is difficult to have staff away from their groups for early dismissals.

Regular drop off – 8:30-9:05am

LATE ARRIVALS

Morning drop off ends promptly at 9:00 AM. After that, our "camp drop off has ended" sign is placed in the road and all late arrivals must park and call the office and a camp staff member will then escort your camper to join the fun.

The app will begin to recognize your child in future photos, and unfortunately, will not identify previous photos.
