DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP NOTES

If you are planning to pick your camper up early, the camp office must receive a written note, email or phone call informing us of the early dismissal (no later than 12:00 am that morning.) We will then have your camper waiting. Please note that the end of the day is quite busy and it is difficult to have staff away from their groups for early dismissals so early pickups may not be able to be accommodated if the office is not given proper notification.

Arrival Information:

Before care – 8-8:30am, park and walk your child to the front door

Regular drop off – 8:30-9:05am *LATE ARRIVALS*

Morning drop off ends promptly at 9:00 AM. After that, our "camp drop off has ended" sign is placed in the road and all late arrivals must park and call the office and a camp staff member will then escort your camper to join the fun.
