DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP NOTES

Thank you for all of your patience and help with our drop-off and pick-up this week. After the first day learning curve, everyone began to see how our system works in a safe and efficient manner. As a reminder, please remain in your car in the afternoon until your child is walked out, in case you are asked to pull forward. If you are planning to pick your camper up early, the camp office must receive a written note, email or phone call informing us of the early dismissal (no later than 11:00 am that morning.) We will then have your camper waiting. Please note that they will be taken back to their group if you are more than ten minutes late.

Arrival Information:

Before care – 8-8:30am, park and walk your child to the front door

Regular drop off – 8:30-9:05am

LATE ARRIVALS

Morning drop off ends promptly at 9:00 AM. After that, our “camp drop off has ended” sign is placed in the road and all late arrivals must park and call the office and a camp staff member will then escort your camper to join the fun.
