DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP NOTES CARPOOL

A few reminders:

- Remember you can start dropping off in the carpool line at 8:30 am. We recommend you try to arrive prior to 8:50 so that when we stop the carpool line at 9:00 AM you have already dropped off your camper.
- When arriving for afternoon carpool, please have your carpool sign already in your dashboard so our staff can best assist you and help to keep the process moving.

 Please remember to go slow when entering onto our campus and through the carpool line (including before care and aftercare campers). When you arrive and are asked to drive through the temple's parking lot, please remember to drive slow as they also are dismissing campers at the same time.

Before care Reminder:

 If you are signed up for before care, please go to the outer lane so you can park and walk your camper to the front entrance where a staff member will take your camper quickly so you can go to work.

LATE ARRIVALS

Morning drop- off ends promptly at 9:00 AM. After that, our "camp drop off has ended" sign is placed in the road. If you arrive after morning carpool ends (at 9:00 am), then please park and walk your camper to the main door and call 561-732-7620. A staff member will greet you and walk your camper to his/her group.

As a reminder, please remain in your car in the afternoon until your child is walked out, in case you are asked to pull forward. If you are planning to pick your camper up early, the <u>camp office</u> <u>must receive a written note, email or phone call informing us of the early dismissal</u> (no later than 12:00 am that morning.) We will then have your camper waiting. Please note that the end of the day is quite busy and it is difficult to have staff away from their groups for early dismissals.
